10 session study. Mentor preparation. Practically focused. Discipler's heart – command to disciple, facing fears, own personal growth. Tools – Testimony, basic disciplines (wheel), Bible reading (hand). Skills – selection of other woman (FATness), topics to teach on, keeping a notebook.

Multiply: Disciples Making Disciples, Francis Chan, David Cook Publishers, 2012.

Small group study and reading text. 25 sessions with short video available. Vision focused, emphasis on study and knowledge of Bible. Command to make disciples, Life in the church community, How to study the Bible, Understanding the Old Testament (creation, fall, Abrahamic covenant, exodus, Mosaic covenant, sacrifice, atonement, kingdom of God, exile and restoration), Understanding New Testament (messiah, great commission, Holy Spirit, early church, good news, second coming).

<u>Discipleship Essentials: Guide to Building Your Life in Christ</u>, Greg Ogden, Intervarsity Press, 2007. 25 topical studies for small group or individual use. Focused on vision, knowledge, and character development. Part 1 – Spiritual Disciplines (being a disciple, quiet time, Bible study, prayer, worship). Part 2 – Understanding message of Christ (trinity, God's image, sin, grace, redemption, justification, adoption). Part 3 – Becoming like Christ (Holy Spirit, fruit of HS, trust, love, justice, witness). Part 4 – Serving the church (church, spiritual gifts, spiritual warfare, obedience, use of money, multiplication).

Growing in Christ, Navpress, a 13 week study on the basics of the Christian walk. For new believers.

Design For Discipleship (DFD), Navpress.

7 book series (5 weeks per book) that provides a solid foundation for growing believers. Some overlap with Growing in Christ. Great topics in reasonable depth, can be downloaded from www.NavPress.com and reproduced for sessions.

<u>Disciples are Made not Born</u>, Walt Henrichsen, 2002.

Vision focused text (not study). Good for mentor discussion group. A classic about how to train a disciple, provides an overarching vision for how and why you invest in someone.

The Master Plan of Evangelism, Robert Coleman, 2010.

Vision focused. Great small group Bible study. How Christ made disciples, emphasizing in-depth investment in a few people.

<u>Transforming Discipleship</u>, Greg Ogden, 2003. Analysis of need for discipleship in the church, Jesus and Paul's models, vision for individual transformation and multi-generational disciple-making. Good read for church leadership.

Woman to Woman: Preparing Yourself to Mentor, Edna Ellis, 2011.

18 session study, Preparing Your Heart, Role of a Mentor (servant, encourager, teacher, counsellor, guide), Keys to Mentoring (transparency, intimacy, God's eyes, confidentiality, accountability), Keeping Balance (boundaries, personal growth, age).
